The Administration recommends that the Board of Education authorize The School District of Philadelphia, through the Superintendent or his designee, to execute and perform a contract, subject to funding, as follows:

Description:

Why is this contract needed?

The Office of Facilities Management and Services has the need for a provider of on-site custodial equipment repairs on an as-needed basis at all District schools. This provider will support the Office of Facilities Management and Services by providing a technician and service vehicle for on-call, emergency, and preventative maintenance. The custodial equipment that will be serviced includes, but is not limited to, the repair of floor scrubbers, vacuum cleaners, wet and dry pickups, burnishers, carpet extractors, and walk-behind machines. Completion of work will be monitored by Facilities Management based on the schedule submitted in accordance with the project. Utilization of these services supports the District's goal

in providing 100% of students with a safe, healthy, and welcoming learning environment.

The success of the contract will be measured by the Office of Facilities Management & Service through the consistent receipt of accurate and complete reports that meet the specified contractual requirements.
