For inspection of elevators in accordance with Section 405.7 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Uniform Commercial Code for Elevators

All vendors will be paid out of the aggregate amount not to exceed \$180,000

All vendors will be paid out of the aggregate amount not to exceed \$50,000

Description:

Why is this contract needed?

The Office of Facilities Management & Services has recognized the need for bi-annual inspections and oversight of required testing for the School District's elevators. A third-party agency is needed to conduct these inspections and ensure compliance with the Uniform Construction Code, with intervals no longer than 6 months. Additionally, the agency must be present to witness the required 3-year and 5-year testing.

How will the success of this contract be measured?

Vendors will be overseen by department supervisors, who will track their performance based on the work schedule provided for testing and inspections. Supervisors will ensure that the vendors adhere to the agreed timelines and meet all necessary requirements for the inspections and testing.
