Why is this contract needed?

The Office of School Safety requires a supplier for uniforms for School Safety personnel on an as-needed basis. Supplying uniforms is essential in ensuring that School Safety staff are regularly wearing the appropriate attire while supporting District schools and administrative offices. Uniforms will be requested from the supplier on an as-needed basis in the event of new hires, uniform updates, or replacement uniforms for existing staff.
