Description:

The Office of Capital Programs had identified a need to provide additional educational space at Meredith Elementary School, which has experienced steadily increasing enrollment. Capital Programs determined that the most expeditious method to accommodate the growth is a four-classroom modular building. The vendor, Modular Genius, was selected from a competitive bid cooperative contract through the Keystone Purchasing Network. The contract's ratification and extension is necessary to pay for completed work in excess of the existing authorization. The Operations division has established a goal to provide a safe, healthy, and welcoming learning environment for all students. Long-term space and enrollment needs at Wm. M. Meredith ES and surrounding schools will be addressed through the District's Multi-year Comprehensive School Planning Review.
